All teams, individual riders and coaches are invited to represent their schools in the parade of competitors on Saturday. Individuals riding on Saturday but not riding on a team Sunday are invited to walk in the parade and be recognized.

IDA Code of Conduct

Intercollegiate Dressage Association (IDA) Members, including riders, coaches, officials, and volunteers must conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, and are responsible for their actions in competitions, going to and from competitions, and while at areas hosting competitions. Members are responsible for adherence to IDA competition rules and procedures. IN all equestrian sports the well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of trainers, riders, owners, organizers, sponsors, or officials. IN the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider is essential. All riding and training methods must demonstrate respect for the horse as a living entity and may not include any technique considered to be abusive or overtaxing of the horse's ability or fitness.

NOTE: Anyone may approach the steward or show management to report violations(s) to the IDA Code of Conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification from an event, loss of points earned at the event and possibly prevent participation in future IDA events at the discretion of show management, show steward and/or IDA Board.

Mission:

The mission of IDA is to introduce students to the equestrian discipline of dressage and to foster continued development, understanding and appreciation in the art of dressage through organized student competitions and educational opportunities.

Please note the following:

- ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required for all riders and must be worn while mounted.
- The show will be run according to USEF rules.
- Entry Fees and Liability Release forms must be collected before competition begins.
- Lake Erie College and its employees will not be held responsible for loss or damage to persons, property, or horse.
- Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. No smoking is allowed in any buildings or stables.
- All dogs must be on a leash which is held by a person. Dogs are not allowed in the Learning Center (owners will be fined \$50 if dog is not on a leash)

Accident Preparedness Plan

BIOSECURITY

Lake Erie College is committed to the health and safety of our resident horses and all of our visiting competition horses. To encourage everyone on the premises to use good practices and health safety measures to protect our horses, please observe the following suggestions:

At the Show

Wash and disinfect your hands frequently!

Do not handle or pet horses other than your own.

Do not let your horse touch other horses, particularly nose-to-nose.

Do not share water buckets, feed tubs, tack or other equipment between horses.

You may elect to take temperatures on your horses twice daily. Report any temperatures over 102.0 to the Show Manager.

Going Home

Clean and disinfect your tack, boots, equipment and grooming supplies.

When you get home, shower, blow your nose and put on clean clothes and shoes before going near other horses at home.
