IDA Code of Conduct

Intercollegiate Dressage Association (IDA) Members, including riders, coaches, officials, and volunteers must conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, and are responsible for their actions in competitions, going to and from competitions, and while at areas hosting competitions. Members are responsible for adherence to IDA competition rules and procedures. IN all equestrian sports the well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of trainers, riders, owners, organizers, sponsors, or officials. IN the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider is essential. All riding and training methods must demonstrate respect for the horse

as a living entity and may not include any technique considered to be abusive or overtaxing of the horse's ability or fitness.

NOTE: Anyone may approach the steward or show management to report violations(s) to the IDA Code of Conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification from an event, loss of points earned at the event and possibly prevent participation in future IDA events at the discretion of show management, show steward and/or IDA Board.

Mission:

The mission of IDA is to introduce students to the equestrian discipline of dressage and to foster continued development, understanding and appreciation in the art of dressage through organized student competitions and educational opportunities.

Please note the following:

- ASTM/SEI approved headgear is required for all riders and must be worn while mounted.
- The show will be run according to USEF rules.
- Entry Fees and Liability Release forms must be collected before competition begins.
